Violations Addressed

Wage Theft

The WRC has helped workers recover tens of millions of dollars in wages stolen from them when their employers failed to pay them the correct minimum wage, severance, or overtime pay.

Health and Safety

The WRC has helped workers eliminate dangerous—sometimes life-threatening—safety hazards from their workplaces, such as toxic chemicals, dangerously high temperatures, and a lack of fire exits.

Wrongful Termination

The WRC has helped win reinstatement for worker leaders who have been illegally or wrongfully fired in retaliation for exercising their associational rights, such as by forming a union or by asking for help from local women's or human rights NGOs.
